*Statement:*

The National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic thanks the UN Statistics Division for the work done and separately expresses gratitude to the UNSD-DFID SDG Monitoring Project for assistance in building an effective SDG monitoring system in the Kyrgyz Republic. With the support of the project, the NSC succeeded in:

- increase the capacity of the statistical system in preparing data and metadata for SDG indicators;
- develop a regular system for collecting data and metadata;
- increase the capacity to apply SDMX standards and implement SDMX standards for all available global and national SDG indicators;
- develop metadata for all global and national SDG indicators;
- to develop the National SDG Reporting Platform - Open SDG KG, where today the global and national SDG indicators in SDMX format are placed, as well as metadata for each indicator;
- improve communication with users and producers of SDG statistics;
- to develop a monitoring system "Impact of COVID-19 on the socio-economic situation of the Kyrgyz Republic".

In 2020, the Kyrgyz Republic provided its first National Voluntary Review on the progress towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals in the Kyrgyz Republic (NVR) and thanks to an effective SDG monitoring system, the National Statistical Committee provided timely, high-quality, official data on the SDGs, and also provided the SDG Platform as a statistical NDO applications.

All these achievements are the basis for the further development of the statistical system and the expansion of the experience gained in other areas of statistics.

For our part, we look forward to further fruitful cooperation, during which we can increase the statistical capacity for the SDGs and the entire system.
