We support the UNSD in continuing to implement the unified information system for global national data centers in order to enhance the capacity of the systems of national and global statistics.

We support the role of the global network of statistical training institutions in order to benefit from them in the field of capacity building to meet the needs of the national statistical offices. We stress the need to benefit from e-learning courses on familiarity with statistical issues for statisticians in general, especially in light of the Corona pandemic, and what it requires of him to work to implement additional courses of learning

We value the launch of the global network of data scientists and statisticians, as it is good to work through this network to exchange experiences and knowledge, networking and technical cooperation that will support national statistical systems for implementing the SDGs.

We support the efforts of the UNSD, the survey, related to monitoring the Covid-19 crisis, of national statistical offices in its three rounds.
