<i>Statement:</i> Unofficial translation: 1 - The State of Palestine emphasizes the role and importance of the Road Map, as it represents a commitment for the United Nations System to ensure enhanced coordination, and to request an update of the data and statistics issued by it. 2 - The State of Palestine believes that the aforementioned road map constitutes an essential path for increasing coordination, and we stress the importance of geospatial information and training in geospatial methods. We urge all countries to consider it a basic path in disseminating data, especially given the circumstances that the world lives in imposing new statistical tools and methods for us to adopt. We hope that the Road Map will be a gateway to that. 3 - The State of Palestine supports the directions and priorities of the Committee's work and affirms the continuation and strengthening of efforts to move forward with the implementation of the Road Map.
