<i>Statement:</i> <p>The Republic of Korea would like to thank the CCS-UN for developing the System-wide Road Map for Innovating UN Data and Statistics aiming to improve its delivery of statistical assistance and coordination for the member states.</p> <p>Regarding priority areas in the Road Map, the planning and implementation of relevant work programmes have been well organized according to their importance.</p> <p>Nevertheless, we would like to suggest that Targets under Goal 1 will be included in the priority work programme for the Committee.</p> <p>Especially, needs for use of new data sources have continued to grow in a crisis like COVID-19.</p> <p>Therefore, we hope that actions for improving data sources for the UN and its member states, such as building a consensus among different communities, putting in place legislative and institutional measures, and obtaining skills, are added to the priority work programme.</p>
