Statement:
Colombia welcomes the report on the management and modernization of statistical systems, and
values the progress of the fourth version of the Manual on the management and organization of
national statistical systems, because in addition to guiding the development and maintenance of
statistical capacity, it will contribute to strengthening the quality of statistics legal, institutional and
organizational frameworks, as well as promoting the planning of statistical production in the
generation of new indicators, a higher level of granularity through the use of new sources of
information such as big data and administrative records.
It will also guide statistical organizations on critical, new and emerging issues and how to measure
and cushion the impact of situations affecting countries through the collaborative work between the
stakeholders of the Statistical Community. Particularly, Colombia considers that the guidelines of the
Manual and the effort of the members of the advisory group are highlighted amid the Global
Pandemic.
Moreover, it is considered that the initiative to have a friendly and interactive web tool for the
dissemination of the draft of the fourth version of the manual and the inclusion of comments and
good practices and as a mechanism for future updates of the manual, is relevant and appropriate.
However, a module is incorporated that allows the consultation of the different versions of the
document in order to have traceability of the modifications and adjustments made to the document
as well as a module to consult the manual in different languages could be of use.
For future updates of the manual, it is suggested to include in the web tool a questionnaire to be
filled out by the countries-within an agreed period- to gather inputs on matters such as: i) the new
topics to be included in the next version; ii) the best statistical practices of the countries that are not
included in the current version; iii) the willingness of the members to participate in the team
responsible for the maintenance and future update of the manual. With this, the Commission can
map out routes or options for future updates of the manual.
Finally, Colombia highlights the importance of taking advantage of the existing institutional set-up,
specifically of the Economic Regional Commissions and their specific bodies to incentivize the
participation of different countries in this new stage, Colombia manifests its interest in joining the
Advisory Group.
