<i>Statement:</i> <p>The National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic welcomes the following thematic methodologies developed by the Intersecretariat Working Group on Household Surveys:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Development of standards for the determining costs on education based on household survey data;-Measuring food consumption in household surveys;-Work on creating and testing a questionnaire module on SDG 16 indicators for inclusion in current household surveys;-Promote consistent assessment of the performance of paid and unpaid work. <p>The National Statistical Committee supports the “Planning and Implementing Household Surveys Under COVID-19” Guidelines for Planning and Implementing Household Surveys Under COVID-19, and took note of this tool.</p> <p>The National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic in the context of COVID-19 in October-November 2020 conducted several surveys aimed at collecting statistical data to monitor the impact of COVID-19 in the Kyrgyz Republic:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) The “Impact of COVID-19 on Households” survey was conducted among respondents to the Integrated Household and Labor Force Survey (IHS). This survey collected data on the impact of COVID-19 on households, access to food and services, education, etc.2) "Impact of COVID-19 on the situation of children and women in the Kyrgyz Republic" this survey was conducted among the respondents of the Multiple Indicators Cluster Survey with the support of the United Nations Children's Fund in the Kyrgyz Republic (UNICEF). The purpose of this survey is to collect data on the impact of COVID-19 on the situation of women and children in the Kyrgyz Republic, as well as to collect telephone numbers of the KOMP-2018 respondents for subsequent use in conducting household surveys.
