<i>Statement provided by:</i> National Statistical Committee of Kyrgyz Republic	
<i>Statement:</i> The National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic supports efforts to automate the data compilation process and use the Statistical Data and Metadata Exchange (SDMX) standard for automated data exchange. I would like to note that, within the framework of the UNSD-DFID project, today the Kyrgyz Republic has transformed all 102 global and 57 national SDG indicators with an accessible desegregation into the SDMX format, which are already posted on the National SDG Reporting Platform of the Kyrgyz Republic, as well as on the UN global platform. Kyrgyzstan plans to continue working on the implementation of SDMX standards for other sectors of statistics, and is also interested in starting work on converting SDG indicators metadata into SDMX format. The NSC supports the concept and future directions for the creation of a new UNdata portal for the submission and dissemination of data and metadata, as well as the creation of an inter-agency and expert mechanism for the comprehensive development and creation of a new United Nations data storage and processing center and for the regular review and updating of data and metadata and approve the proposed terms of reference.
