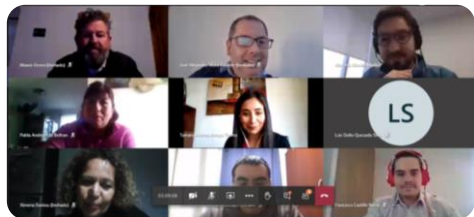
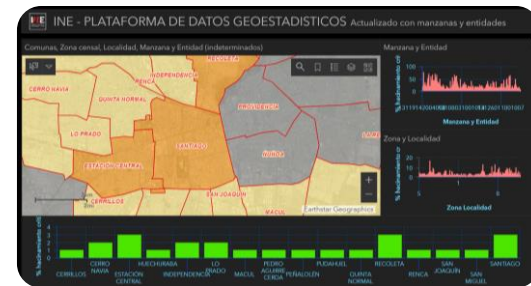
IN ORDER TO ADAPT OUR PRODUCTION

Dissemination activities

Focused on the impact of the pandemic on statistics

Increase the offer of georeferenced data

Geostatistical data platform (active cases of Covid-19, sociodemographic population data and economic statistics)
