Statement:

Egypt appreciates the efforts made by the high-level group. We support Berne Convention, which calls for work to develop the capacity of preparing data, establish partnerships and produce data in order to leave no one behind. We also agree on the timetable for the action plan for the year 2022, and we refer to the CAPMAS interest in improving data for sustainable development and preparing periodic reports to follow up on the indicators of the goals, as well as for the preparation of voluntary reports. It also monitors the second statistical report to follow up on the indicators that were measured with an availability rate of 47.5% and highlights the gaps related to some indicators. Egypt also joined the task force specialized in following up the official support mechanism provided for sustainable development TOSSD OECD.
