Finland aligns itself with the joint statement of the countries of the EU and the EFTA.	
Finland extends its congratulations to the IAEG-SDGs group and the secretariat for the report. We support the adoption of the new proposed indicators (17.3), including that the OECD and UNCTAD takes on the joint custodianship of the indicator 'Additional financial resources mobilized for developing countries from multiple sources'.	
We consider that the proposal put forward by the IAEG-SDGs group balances the different viewpoints and positions countries brought into the work. The proposal represents a viable way forward within the framework of indicators to follow-up the 2030 Agenda.
