<i>Statement provided by:</i> Mr. Batdavaa Batmunkh Chairman National Statistics Office of Mongolia	
<i>Statement:</i> <p>The NSO Mongolia aims to determine the best way to integrate internal systems of public organizations in the country, to improve standardization, and to cooperate with the private sector and users on sharing data. We have initiated a Government Integrated Database Project that has not started yet. According to our plan, a big data analyzing center will be set up in next five years. Then we expect to coordinate and manage data stewardship in the light of the project. In accordance with data stewardship implementation, our main duties will be expanded and legal frameworks on cooperating various stakeholders and sharing data must be revised. Therefore, to improve data governance, it requires first to build data value chain at the national level, to define duties and collaboration of all stakeholders, to assess legal frameworks, as well as to determine further changes. Also, one important aspect is that all stakeholders should have mutual understanding of data stewardship. Furthermore, we need to improve public data literacy, to build capacity building of public data specialists as well as to enhance data safety and security.</p> <p>We propose establishing a regional advisory group on an integrated government database, data stewardship to study and share the best experience and practices in this field.</p>
