Statement:
Mexico endorses the report and points for discussion. In 2022, we will continue to share our experience conducting the 2020 Population and Housing Census with other National Statistical Offices and expert groups.
Regarding the encouragement to establish a national statistical population register based on the census master file, it should be noticed that not all the countries, including México, collect personal information that allows its integration in a population register. For this reason, we should make efforts to reinforce statistical population registers produced by Governmental Offices and other administrative data to strengthen national statistics. In this strategy, Governmental Offices must gran the National Statistics Office access to nominal administrative registers for statistical purposes.
