Egypt supports the report of the expert group on statistics related to statelessness and on the legal definition of statelessness and stresses the importance of coordination with statistical stakeholders (Ministry of Interior - High Commissioner for Migration - Ministry of Foreign Affairs) to formulate questions for data sources covering statelessness, and coordination with the Ministry of Interior and civil records regarding stateless persons who were born in a country and those who were born in the country and related to stateless persons, also indicate the importance of developing international recommendations on reducing statelessness and protecting this vulnerable group and not depriving them of basic rights.
