Statement:

Institute of Statistics appreciates the work done by the Group of Experts on ongoing efforts to improve the production and use of time-use data (TUS survey). Time Use Survey was conducted for the first time in Albania in 2010 for population aged 10 years and older.

The next round of data collection is planned after the Census. INSTAT will consider the minimum harmonized instrument for data collection, also the modernized way of data collection, using digital tools instead of paper diaries.

Production of gender statistics on selected areas of gender concerns, respectively femicide based on ICCS, violence against women and men will be considered for future plans. Another important point will be the incorporation of gender perspective in all statistical themes produced by INSTAT.
