<i>Statement:</i> Bangladesh appreciates the initiatives taken to modernize time use data collection. Quality considerations for time-use surveys and options to modernize time-use data production, as the core components of the upcoming update of the United Nations guidelines for producing time-use statistics in an efficient way while promoting international comparability.  In response to the initiatives taken globally, Bangladesh has conducted the Time Use Survey in 2021 in collaboration with UN Women. The survey will provide comprehensive and detailed data on how people are spending their time during a specific period of time.  As the Ex-member of the IAEG-GS, Bangladesh contributed significantly earlier. Still Bangladesh is highly interested to contribute to the group in light of the experienced gathered from generation and compilation of gender statistics including time use survey, violence against women survey, compilation of gender statistics, etc. Bangladesh is interested to share the experience with the global community if required.
