<i>Statement:</i> Spain supports the common position of the EU Member States and EFTA Countries presented by France. Spain also notes the importance of developing a framework for measuring the sustainability of tourism, defining a set of indicators that could be implemented by countries first, on an experimental basis, with the support of the tourism policy stakeholders. To achieve this target, Spain is supportive of a pragmatic stepwise approach. In this sense, countries should be able to provide users with a set of feasible indicators in the short term, by re-using available information as much as possible.
