<i>Statement:</i>	
(a) Malaysia would like to express our sincere gratitude and appreciation on the work undertaken by United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) on the launched of a Global Consultation on the draft Global Set of Climate Change Statistics and Indicators on 21st May 2021 which was developed in close collaboration with the secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). Malaysia also provided our report on the global consultation draft.	
(b) An engagement session with the ministries and agencies involved in collecting data related to climate change indicators was conducted to obtain feedback on the availability of data related to Global Set of Climate Change Statistics and Indicators.	
(c) Malaysia will be setting up a Technical Working Committee on Climate Change Statistics and Indicators with members of various ministries and agencies as a coordination mechanism in compiling the climate change statistics.	
(d) Malaysia also expresses the need for capacity-building and acknowledges investment required in the infrastructure related to compilation Climate Change Statistics and Indicators.
