<i>Statement:</i> <p>Mexico supports the update of the SNA 2008 version to the SNA 2025, in particular on priority issues of the National Accounts and is currently working on measurements of the distributive variables of households (Disposable Income, Consumption and Save), issues about FINTECH and intellectual property, digital supply and use charts, value added of digital products and satellite accounts of the ecosystems. In addition, as a line product, it calculates the value added of electronic commerce.</p> <p>Mexico, through INEGI, supports and actively participates in ECLAC seminars in matters of National Accounts, as well as in events held for this purpose at the IMF and the OECD. Mexico also participates in the G20 Data Gaps Initiative (DGI) activities, seminars, etc., organized by the IMF in coordination with the Countries Presidencies.</p> <p>Mexico supports the guidance notes and is participating in the consultations carried out on the 2008 SNA issues, as well as the guidance notes and their experimentation tests.</p> <p>Mexico takes note that, as the work on the update of the 2008 SNA progresses, it was decided to appoint a Lead editor to facilitate the drafting of the update of the 2008 SNA and a Project manager to assist the ISWGNA in coordinating the update process using the existing institutional arrangements and project infrastructure.</p> <p>Mexico agrees with the work programmes by the WG and of the regional commissions. INEGI has participated and will continue to participate in various training workshops and seminars organized by the Working Group and the regional commissions.</p> <p>Mexico, through INEGI, shares information from National Accounts in a timely manner to the corresponding international organizations, and it should be noted that even with the problems with the health contingency due to COVID 19, none of the products of the National accounts has stopped being published.</p>
