<i>Statement:</i> We appreciate the progress made by the Network and its sprints, and we support the terms of reference and the work of the Network for the year 2022. We agree with the importance accorded to the Network because it facilitates the cooperation and coordination of national statistical offices of all member states and their close consultation with international and regional organizations and with statistical agencies. Through networking, statistical offices could develop innovative and coordinated statistical programs and adopt best practices and working methods in collaboration with other government agencies, academia, and private organizations to produce reliable and timely statistics. We urge the Network to conduct regular consultations with users and to promote communications through forums and surveys on emerging themes and common priorities. The Network should enable statistical systems to assist in integrating economic statistics by expanding the statistical framework, as well as to attain better granularity and timeliness and to integrate measurements of the economy, society, and environment.
