Statement:

1. The Central Classification of Products (CPC1) issued by the United Nations Statistics Division is currently used, and work is currently being updated to the CPC2.1 classifications.
2. Work is currently being done by the Agricultural Statistics using the Fourth Standard Classification of Economic Activities (ISIC4), and linking it with the Central Classification of Products (CPC2.1) to cover all activities in the agricultural sector.
3. The data is provided through visits within the selected sample.
4. The review of agricultural statistics for the use of administrative records is carried out more broadly through coordination with all agencies concerned with the agricultural sector.
5. The agricultural and environmental sector data are collected periodically (annual, quarterly and monthly) or through some administrative records at the relevant ministries, institutions and departments.
6. Agricultural statistics and the environment are currently being reviewed within the project to develop national accounts at the national level in Jordan.
7. The data of the agriculture and environment sector is published on the website of the Department of Statistics through the following link:

8. The difficulties that the agriculture and environment sector have faced recently is the Corona pandemic, as data collection has become more difficult.
9. Emphasis is given to capacity building with regard to food security, agricultural and environmental statistics.
