<i>Statement provided by:</i> Chile	
<i>Statement:</i> For INE-Chile, the manner in which we communicate our information is undoubtedly crucial for adequately disseminating our data and ensuring that it is understood and interpreted correctly. This is the only way to fulfill the mandate of making quality data available for decision-making in public policy. The efforts of this working group are essential to the promotion of data that is readily available and easily understood. The recommendation of making data widely accessible fosters the transparency with which we as NSOs provide information. In addition, by focusing on our users, we can improve the relevance of the information that we generate and can make it more useful for those who work with information that we provide in our role as NSOs. In 2021, INE-Chile was evaluated by Open Data Watch (ODW), an institution that is part of the working group. ODW evaluated how we make our information available to the public and indicated a path for improvement in our dissemination of information. We took note of this advice and have applied it to our efforts to open our data to users by promoting the interoperability of statistical data.
