<i>Statement:</i> For the 1st time to conduct Population and Housing Census 2022 almost 450,000 (Four Hundred and Fifty Thousands) Geographic Information System (GIS) Maps have been prepared. These include Enumerators Area Maps, Supervisor Control Maps, Zonal Officer control Maps, Upazila, District and Divisional Census coordinator control Maps. The integration among CAPI Apps, ICMS and GIS Maps has been completed successfully. After completion of the data collection of the 6th population and housing census 2021 the Geospatial Data Themes like Global Geodetic Reference frame, Addresses, Buildings and Settlements, Geographical Names and Population Distribution will be collected fully and Functional Areas will be collected partially. To conclude, It is highly expected to monitor the population and housing censuses-implementing worldwide by The United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) to develop standards and norms for statistical and geospatial activities. It is also requested to UNSD for supporting countries` efforts to strengthen their national statistical and geospatial information systems.
