The Statistical Centre of Iran suggests that awarding global prestigious scores and medals/certificates can be a proper way to speed up the participation of private sector and universities in the system of economic statistics.
6	22	The process of selecting the senior experts on economic statistics needs more clarifications.	It is recommended that for selecting the experts and informed people on economic statistics, their educational, scientific, and practical experiences should be considered the highest priority. We propose to select them based on exam/test.
