

### Paper 3.3: Proposal to launch new Task-Teams in Health, Environment and Education

1. The initial task-teams were designed to initiate work in areas where EGWM could beneficially supply immediate briefings to the UN's High Level Expert Group but also to establish structures to progress the work to deliver the Framework for Inclusive and Sustainable Well-being.
2. The six groups, however, omit a number of key areas. When we consider the Sustainable Development Goals we can see important omissions:
  - a. Health (SDG 3)
  - b. Education (SDG 4)
  - c. Environment (SDGs 13-15)
3. The key issue for consideration is whether the EGWM has the resources and partnerships necessary to sustain further groups. Given the conceptual distinctiveness and the fact that we propose to seek both volunteers from the existing EGWM and wider specialist communities, if we cannot find suitable memberships the proposal would be paused for those task-teams which cannot be convened with viable memberships until such memberships could be established.
4. **Proposal:** The bureau seek interest from EGWM members in establishing new task-teams to bring together experts in these areas to develop '4x4' grids and identify potential headline indicators.
5. **Proposal:** The co-chairs reach out to the following organisations to consider their ability to provide potential chairs for task-teams:
  - a. **Health** : World Health Organisation
  - b. **Education** : UNESCO Institute for Statistics (UIS)
  - c. **Environment** : Co-chair model between UNCEEA and UN Environment Program
6. Task-team chairs would be invited to join EGWM and the bureau.
7. In addition, having delivered the communication briefing note, it is proposed to re-focus this group on 'Developing the Framework document' to deliver the design for the physical workshop proposed for September 2025. The argument here is that whilst communications are important, the initial reflections in this area now require the development of outputs before we can do substantively more, unless the High Level Expert Group requests further assistance in this area.
8. **Proposal:** To re-designate the communications task-team to focus on 'Developing the Framework document'.
