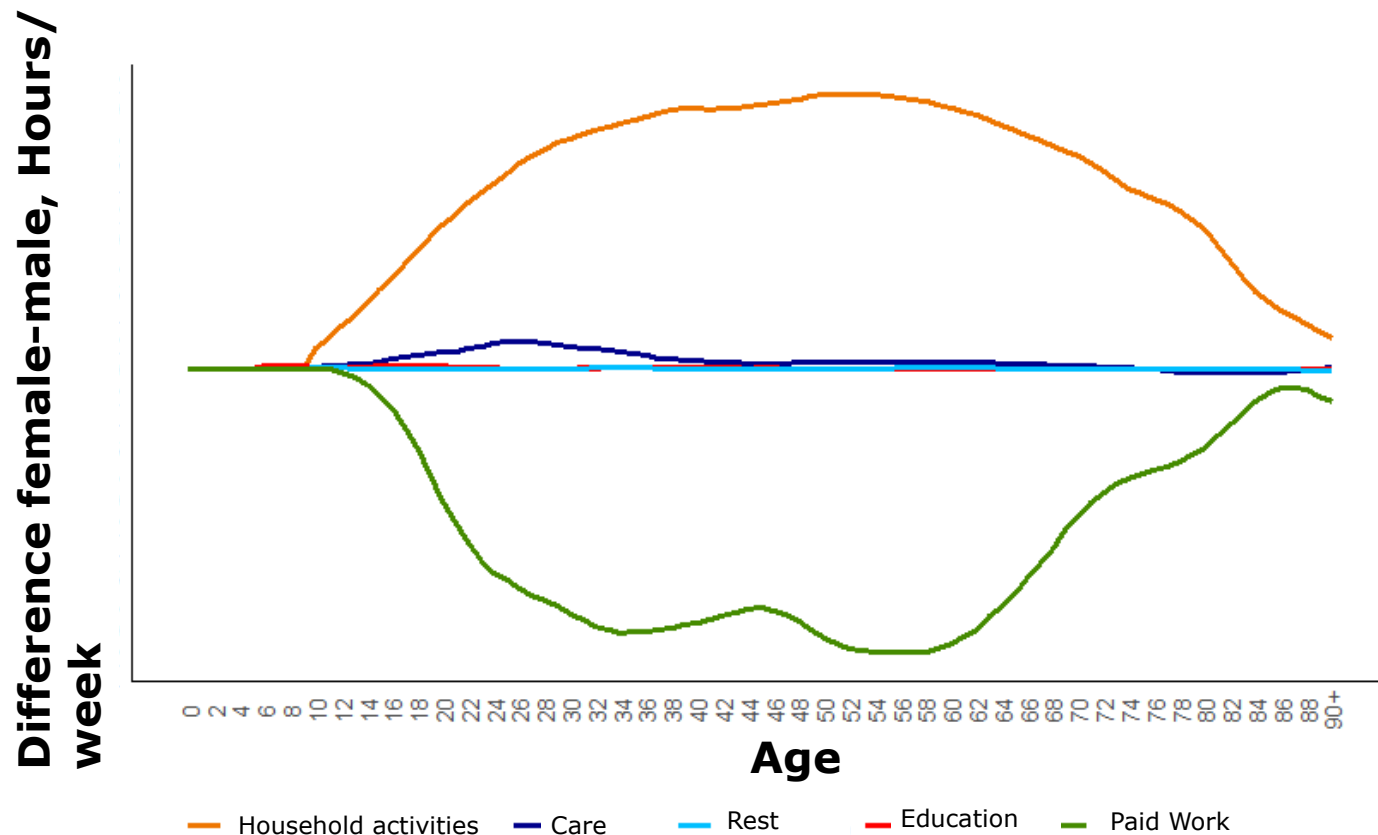


Difference between women and men in time spent on household activities, care, education and paid work (hours per week) by age

2021



Women spend more time than men on household activities, with a difference of 13 hours. The difference reaches its maximum at age 52, where women spend 21 hours more per week.



The difference in dedication to paid work is the inverse of household activities. Men dedicate more time than women to labor market activities, reaching a maximum difference of about 22 hours more per week at age 56. Men spend 11.8 hours more than women in the paid labor market.
