




#### The average by gender

Africa: Ghana, Senegal, South Africa










#### National Time Transfer Accounts


- Measure unpaid care work in time use surveys

- Impute consumption of that time to household members and society










## How does seeing this help us?


- Values people's full contributions to our economies and societies
