National Transfer Accounts for Colombia 2008


DANE acquired the commitment of making the demographic transitions and its economic impact visible though the development of NTA.

Importance & use cases of NTA's

Importance & use cases of NTA's

- The NTA's are based on the concept of generational economics, in which practically all economic activities are significantly influenced by the age structure (consumption, labor participation, savings, use of health services, education, etc.).
- Therefore, changes in the age structure of the population will have significant consequences on economic growth, the sustainability of support system towards the households, the financial market, and the inequality within and between generations, among others.
- The need for the development of NTA's emerged in Colombia in response to the need to have an evidence base to make visible the impact of demographic transitions on aspects such as economic growth, the sustainability of social protection systems and also on public spending on education and health.







How are the 2017 NTA's for Colombia calculated?

The NTA's consist of an accounting system that measures national economic activity by age and records resource flows through the government, the market and households, doing so through **per capita** profiles and generating age aggregates by linking them to the population.

National Houehold Budget Survey (ENPH) 2016-2017

Provides an exhaustive level of detail for income items and their origins, as well as for expenses, in most cases with information by individual.








Income profiles of employees, self-employed, and labor benefits by age 2017






Labor Income per capita

2008 - 2017







Per Capita Consumption

Consumption profiles, public consumption and private consumption by age 2017






Per capita Public consumption Public consumption profiles and their age components 2017



Economic life cycle per capita


Average profiles by age of the labor income and consumption- deficit and surplus stages 2017

Average profiles by age of the labor income and consumption – Life cycle





Public Transfers Inflows (TGI)






Outflows of public transfers (TGO)

Main Highlights & Conclusions

Insights of the Colombian Experience

1.

The NTA's require detailed statistical information on income and expenses at the individual level; thus, it is ideal to guarantee a higher frequency of income and expense surveys or to have a statistical operation to meet this information need.

2.

The importance of the institutional framework for the elaboration of NTA's as a responsibility of the NSO's gains further relevance given the on-going demographic transitions.

A strong institutional framework is an enabler for **ensuring the continuity of the measurement of NTA's.** 3.

Dissemination and literacy campaigns associated with the NTA's for decision makers on the health sector, social protection, education and public finance, remains as a significative challenge that needs to be addressed in order to enable a wider use.

Insights of the Colombian Experience

4.

One of the remaining challenges with the statistical production of the NTA's is the disaggregation of results to allow analysis at the regional, urban and rural levels, with a differential and intersectional approach.

This is due to the aggregation and limitations of the data sources used (administrative records, coefficients of variation of the surveys).

5.

With the elaboration of the NTAs, DANE has contributed contributed to the generation of an official statistic that constitute an important input for the analysis of the generational economy, in view of the demographic phenomenon faced by the country and the region in terms of population aging.
