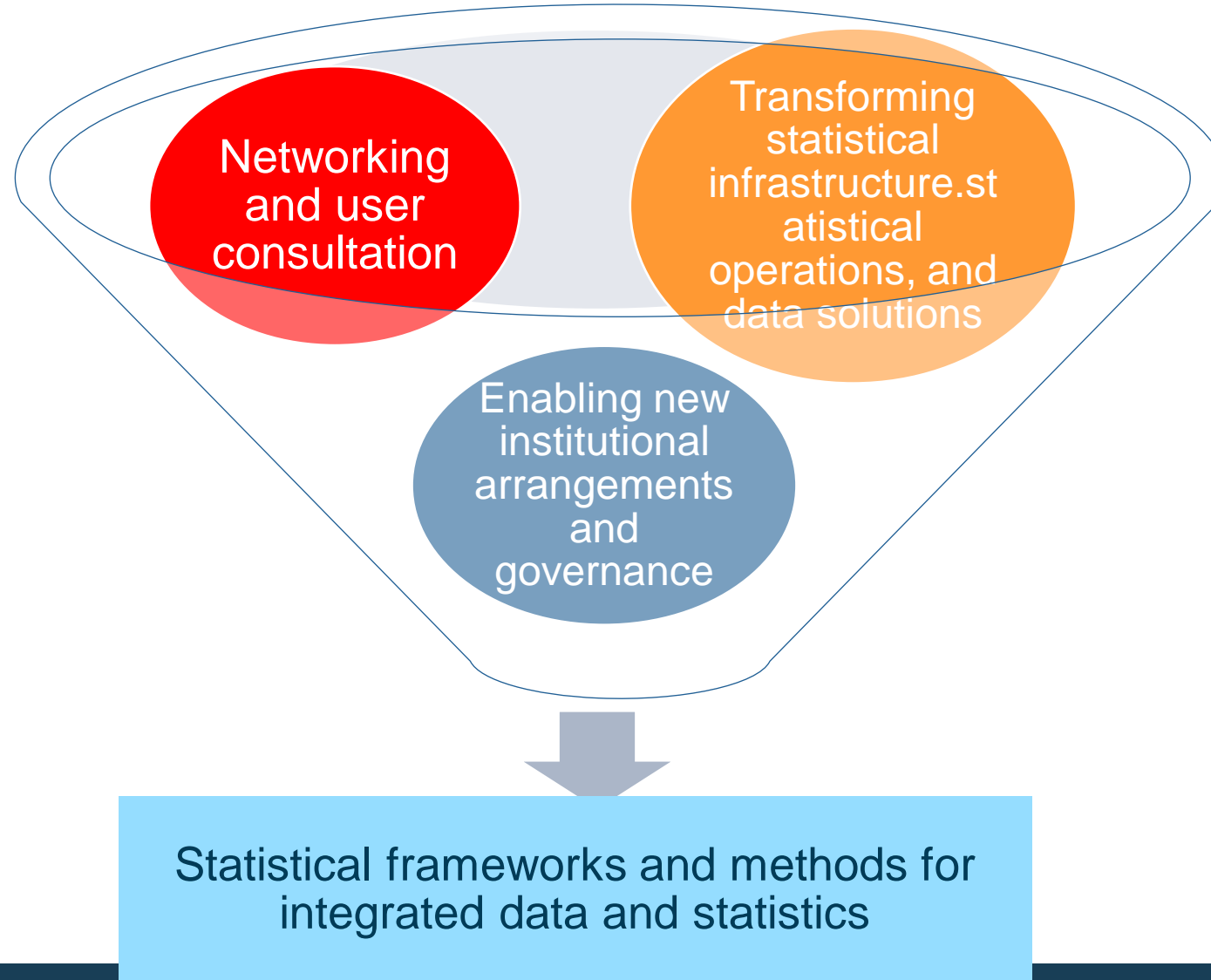

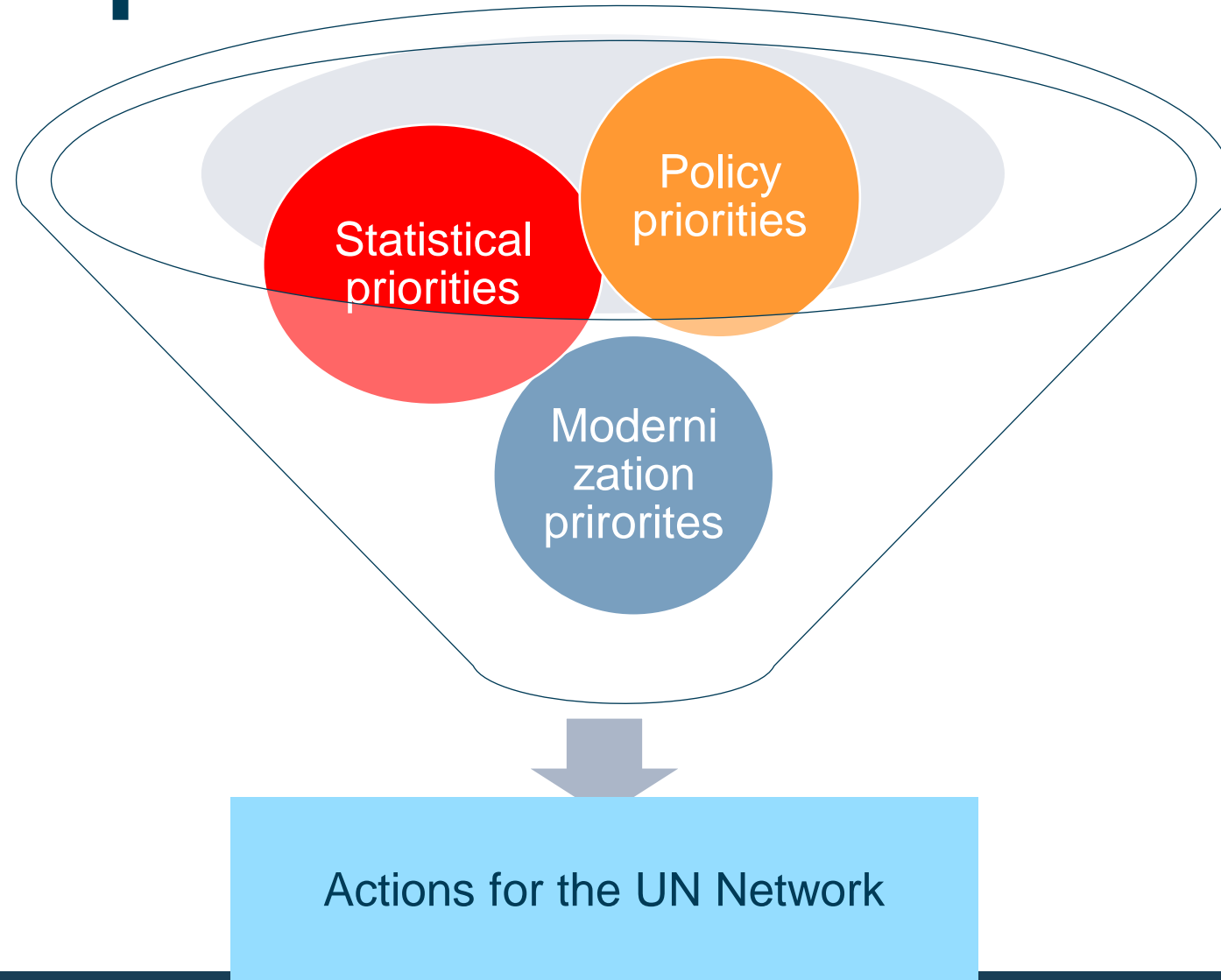

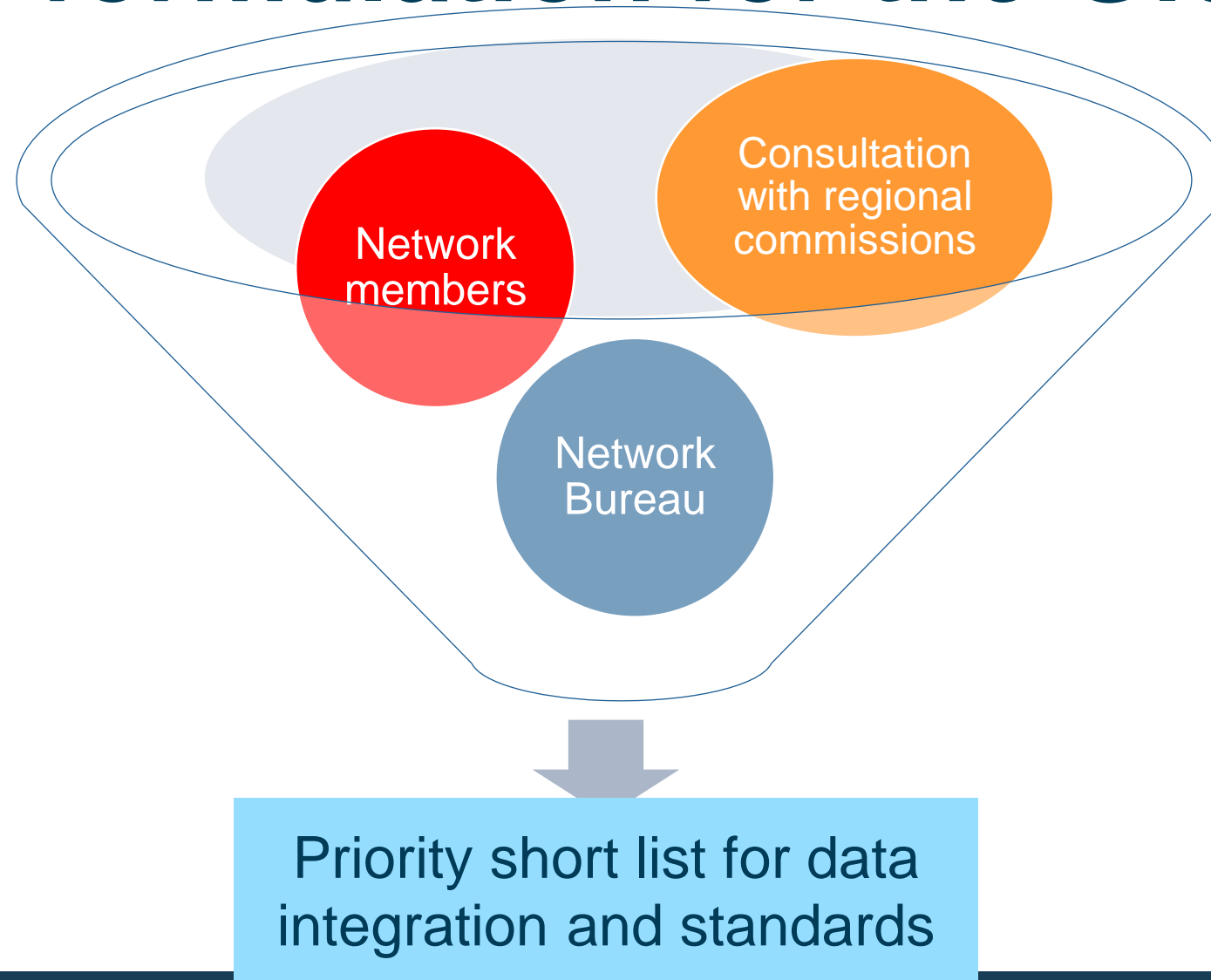

# Priorities of the Global South

Our discussion led to the identification of a number of high level priorities:

- **Growth, national cohesion and well-being**
  - ✓ implementation of 2008 SNA, the development of sub-national GDP indicators and the development of methods and strategies to map and integrate data sources in the absence of regular surveys, were top of mind.
  - ✓ The beyond GDP topics of well-being and sustainability and the digital and creative economy as drivers of growth are important but more aspirational goals
- **Regional Integration and participation in GVCs**
  - ✓ required statistics on regional and global value chains, and related TIVA measures
  - ✓ practices should be shared on data mapping for compilation of international trade statistics and supply-use tables.
- **Price stability and international price comparison**
  - ✓ a need to share practices in the use of scanner data and web scraping techniques
  - ✓ share practices on methodologies to measure price development in the informal market segment of consumer goods and services

# Priorities of the Global South (continued)

- **The Informal Economy**
  - ✓ Leveraging the technological underpinnings (big data generated) of this transformation to measure e-commerce of the informal economy

# Modernization of national statistical agencies in the Global South

Delivering on priorities requires modernization of the statistical system:

- **Data integration techniques**
  - ✓ Combining data from various sources
  - ✓ Consolidating data from multiple sources into one central repository for analysis and reporting
- **Capacity Building and Training**
  - ✓ Training Workshops
  - ✓ Collaboration with Academic Institutions
  - ✓ Knowledge sharing by NSI with experience in specific areas

# Role of the UN Network of Economic Statisticians

- **Enable Knowledge Sharing and Collaboration**
  - ✓ Leverage well-established regional knowledges sharing platforms of the regional commission
  - ✓ Host key note speeches on priority topics at various Network events
- **Facilitate in-kind support by twinning with experts from developed countries on specific topics**
  - ✓ Canada with PPPs in Caribbean
  - ✓ UKONS in Africa on scanner data and data science for statistics
  - ✓ assist in identification of specific expertise such as for the harmonization of classifications and the price measurement of investment in construction.
- **Better representation of the Region in the Network**
  - ✓ Increase representation of Global South on the Network and the Network's Bureau
