#### **Chapter V Quantity Measurement**

#### Introduction

 This chapter and its basic recommendations are largely unchanged but the language has been amended

#### What's new

- The goal to achieve greater uniformity in the reporting of quantity information has been further stressed (Para. 5.5)
- A new recommendation that countries estimate nonreported quantity information (Para 5.4 and 5.6)



# Results of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Worldwide Consultation

- Countries do not always follow the units of quantity recommended by WCO
- Countries request to provide detailed guidance on the recommended estimation of quantity information
- Some countries suggest to provide some clarifications.
