### **Chapter VII Mode of Transport**

#### What's new

- 1. This is a new Chapter.
- 2. 2-digit categories of classification for the compilation and reporting of the trade data by the mode of transport is suggested.
- 3. The classification supports international comparability.
- *4. The classification allows maximum flexibility to countries to implement.*

#### Chapter VII Mode of Transport Main messages

- 1) Para 7.1 It is recommended that countries compile and disseminate international merchandise trade statistics by mode of transport at the most detailed commodity level.
- 2) Para 7.2 Countries are encouraged to use the suggested main categories (1-digit) and the detailed (2-digit) categories
- 3) Para 7.3 The classification is not intended to limit the flexibility of countries to implement.
- 4) Para 7.4 To compile mode of transport not only as <u>the means</u> of transport when crossing the border, but in addition according to different criteria such as for example <u>the predominant mode of</u> <u>transport</u>.



## Results of the 2nd Round of Worldwide Consultation

- Majority welcome this new chapter and the suggested classification.
- An important and good addition to the recommendation.
- Several countries view information on mode of transport as of bad quality, or suggested that the recommendation to be better placed in the Compilers Manual.
