## **GENERALITY**

- Data sources : Customs.
- Existence of Protocol between Customs office and the Statistics office about the statistics of foreign trade.
- Two version of ASYCUDA are used by Customs: ASYCUDA 2.7, ASYCUDA ++.
- System used for compilation: NEW EUROTRACE.
- Two system of validation procedures according to this situation

# CUSTOMS PROCEDURE CODES

- Two types of CPC are using by Customs: the one for ASYCUDA 2.7 and the other for ASYCUDA ++.
- The definition of the type of the flow and the type of trade is based on the CPC.
- The system allows to evaluate trade with the special system and the general system.
- Correspondence table is used to translate CPC to flow or to type of trade.

- Others nomenclatures are used for analysis and diffusion: Utilization Group, BullImport, BullExport, SITC.
- Table of correspondence is made to translate data from HS to this different nomenclature.
