Background

- ❖ April 1997 : COMESA Common Statistical Rules (CSR) and Regulations developed and adopted by COMESA Council of Ministers
- Based on UNSD Concepts and Definitions
- **❖** Objective : Data made comparable at all levels
- ❖ December 2000: CSR Revised according to new Concepts and Definitions of the UNSD
- May 2001: Proposed changes adopted by Directors of Customs and Statistics

Rationale

- The CSR over the years have been overtaken by events!
 - HS product codes change every 5 years
 - Most countries using Asycuda++/World
 - Advancement in technology for data remittance
- Articles become obsolete
- **❖** Revised UNSD Concepts and Definitions IMTS2010



The Amendments

- a) Name should be changed to read: Regulations for Compilation of International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS) in the COMESA Region.
- b) List of Customs Procedure Codes (CPCs) in **Article 5** to follow standard format of Asycuda++ codes whenever possible
- c) Article 7: The Regional COMESA tariff shall be based on the latest WCO's six digit HS of codification
- d) Article 11: Reference to COMESA regional tax codes deleted
- e) Article 12: Form Number limitation to 6 digits, item number 2 digits and office code 4 digits deleted.

The Amendments ctd

- f) Article 13: Registration date changed to assessment date.
- g) Article 17: Regional Centre replaced with Secretariat
- h) Article 18: Items country of last consignment, first destination, freight, insurance and amount of taxes moved to compulsory data.
- i) Article 19: On statistical tables produced deleted.
- j) Article 20: Date of registration changed to assessment
- k) Article 22: Minimum of 3 years for keeping data deleted.
- Article 23: Reference to Article 19 deleted.
- m) Article 24: Changed to include SITC and BEC as other nomenclatures



The Amendments ctd

- n) Article 25: Computerize processing of IMTS deleted
- Article 26: Rephrased to empower the Committee on Statistical Matters
- p) Article 29: To refer to Regulations
- q) Appendix II for Country and Currency codes updated
- r) Appendix IV for CPCs deleted
- s) Appendix VI part b) for HS codes deleted.
- t) Appendix VII for tax codes deleted.



The Committee on Statistics

- ➤ The amendments were presented to the Committee on Statistical Matters for COMESA
- ➤ The Committee was requested to consider and adopt the recommendations for onward presentation to next Council.
- The Committee adopted the recommended amendments.



Way forward and Next Steps

- Amended IMTS Rules and Regulations taken to Legal Drafting Committee
- Drafted IMTS Rules and Regulations presented to Council
- Council adopted new IMTS Rules and Regulations
- New Rules and Regulations came into force August 2010!
