Addressing economic globalization

 understanding the phenomenon and its impact on our societies and economies, where value added and employment is created
Increasing complexity of compiling business and economic statistics

- Multinational enterprise groups: impact on statistics and creating relationships
- Role of Registers on MNES, EGR, ADIMA, GGR
- Quality and consistency of national/European statistics: Data and information sharing also cross-borders; European profiling, LCUs,
- integration of data, domains, sources, coordination globally
- a degree of standardisation e.g. common classification of business functions
- Filling data gaps to provide users with a more comprehensive narrative:
- Global value chains, FDI by ultimate investor, statistics by business functions, Trade in services, services trade by modes of supply, digital trade, Trade by enterprise characteristics
