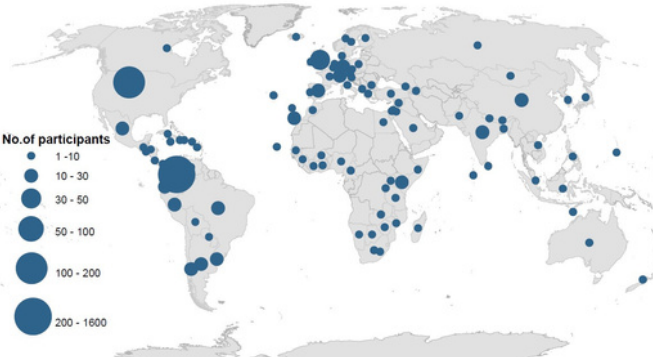

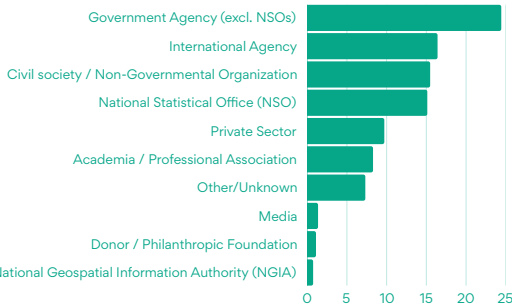
The **UN Datathon 2024**, held from November 8-11, gathered over 200 students to develop solutions for sustainable urban tourism.

This year's Forum marks the **10th anniversary of A World That Counts**, the report that inspired the creation of UN World Data Forum.

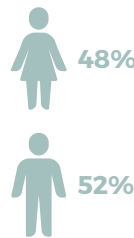
Launched in July 2024, the **"Commit to Data"** campaign seeking concrete commitments to harness data to achieve the SDGs.



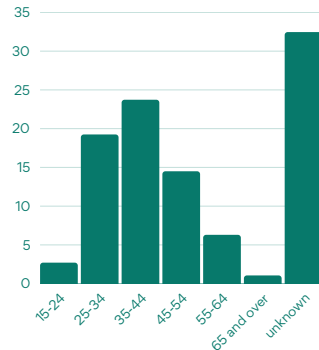
PARTICIPANTS BY ORGANIZATION CATEGORY (%)
