New National statistical priorities resulting from the impact of COVID 19

- The major priorities and lessons from COVID 19 are :
 - Increase the use of modern technology for data collection and dissemination. This includes CAPI, Telephone interview, disseminate data in soft copy, provide virtual trainings
 - Improve electronic data transfer by improving the network connection facilities
 - Use alternative data sources like administrative data, geospatial data
 - The need to produce more disaggregated and timely data
 - The need to improve statistical coordination
 - The need to seriously work on capacity building
 - The need to review the statistics act for better and effective coordination and to consider the new era

Reflections on discussions held during the third world data forum

- During the third world data forum , different sessions which reflects the new need in relation to COVID 19 were organized and valuable discussions were held and useful recommendations come out. Some of them are :
 - sessions organized on the mechanisms to produce more disaggregated data by different characteristics
 - Discussions on innovative methods to produce timely and quality data held
 - Practical example on use of geospatial data, administrative data and citizen generated data was presented
 - Engaging users to improve coordination was discussed
 - Increasing sustainable financing was boldly discussed
- The forum helped to share experience and improve partnership in statistics
- All these discussions created awareness and useful recommendations come out on the Bern Data Compact for the Decade of Action on the Sustainable Development Goals

 - Capacity building to maintain data quality
 - Capacity building on mechanisms for effective data sharing

 - Sustainable financing
