editors and other editors: Finland”****Summary****

The fourth, revised edition of the paper entitled “Toponymic guidelines for map editors and other editors: Finland”, presented at the twenty-second session of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, held in New York in 2004, has been updated (version 4.10, April 2019).

The updates concern the distribution of the population and languages across Finland (section 1, on languages), the list of publications (section 3, on publications) and the list of English names of Finnish regions (section 6.3, on regions) to reflect the situation at the beginning of 2019.

The updated version 4.10 of the paper will be available on the website of the Institute for the Languages of Finland (www.kotus.fi/toponymicguidelines) as well as on the website of the Group of Experts.
