A. Opening and duration of the session

1. Pursuant to Economic and Social Council decision 2021/213, and taking into account the prevailing conditions related to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic affecting the working arrangements and the available technological and procedural solutions in the interim period, the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names did not hold formal meetings during its second session. The Group of Experts held 10 online informal meetings with remote simultaneous interpretation from 3 to 7 May 2021, pursuant to Council decision 2018/2.
