The full report includes the achievements of Jordan in the field of standardizing geographical names and the role of the National Committee on Geographical Names in conducting several courses on geographical names, defining country dictionaries and name indexes, applying the romanization system and issuing the geographical names magazine.

Jordan, represented by the Royal Jordanian Geographical Centre, provided other countries with assistance and support in organizing conferences and meetings related to the standardization of geographical names.

The full report presents the activities of Jordan in the period 2021–2022 in accordance with the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names strategic plan for 2021–2029 and in response to the resolutions adopted at the various sessions of the United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names.
