Report of Croatia on the activities in the field of standardization of geographical names in 2022

Submitted by Croatia **

Summary:

The report of Croatia will present activities in the field of standardization of geographical names in the country in 2022. The report of Croatia for 2021 was submitted to the East Central and South-East Europe Division of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names and published in the Group's information bulletin. In 2022, the Commission for the Standardization of Geographical Names of Croatia held nine meetings and worked, through its working groups, on four strategic documents (which it adopted) for the purpose of quality assurance of the register of geographical names. With the implementation of the new Law on Settlements, local self-government units are obliged to obtain the opinion of the Commission on the proposed name of a settlement, street or square. Activities (part of a pilot project) relating to the revision of some records in the database of the register of geographical names were completed, with a review. The drafting of a set of recommendations for the standardization of geographic names in the country, a publication on geographical names, improving the functionality of the network application of the register of geographical names, and upgrading the website of the register are under way. The Commission continues to give its expert opinion to users and the interested public on suggestions for naming or changing the names of geographical objects in the country.

National report

A Summary

The national report on activities on the standardization of geographical names in the Republic of Croatia for 2021 was submitted to ECSEED/UNGEGN and published in the UNGEGN information bulletin.

The Commission for the Standardization of Geographical Names in 2022 held nine meetings and worked continuously, through its working groups, on four strategic documents (which are adopted) for the purpose of quality assurance of the Register of Geographical Names.

With the implementation of the new Law on Settlements, local self-government units are obliged to obtain the opinion of the Commission for the Standardization of Geographical Names on the proposed name of the settlement, street or square.

Activities (pilot project) on the revision of some records in the database of the Register of Geographical Names were completed with a review.

Writing one Recommendations for the standardization of geographic names in the Republic of Croatia; publication on geographical names; improving functionality of the network application of the Register of Geographical Names and upgrading website of the Register of Geographical Names are in process.

The Commission for Standardization of Geographical Names continuously gives its expert opinions to the users / interested public, related to the suggestions for naming and / or changing the geographical names of geographical objects in the Republic of Croatia.

B Member state report on the situation in their country

The progress made in the standardization of geographical names since the last UNGEGN session (news in the field of geonames in the country, progress of ongoing projects, finished projects, issues and use cases for inspiration for other countries, changes in database of geonames).

April 2022 – Implementation of the new Law on Settlements. Local self-government units are obliged to obtain the opinion of the Commission for the Standardization of Geographical Names on the proposed name of the settlement, street or square.
