Why We Need Guidelines

- Evolving focus since 1992 UNCSGN
- From indigenous and minority names
- > To historical names, resilience, and cultural significance
- Urgent Needs
- > Threats from urbanization and modernization
- > Need for cultural sensitivity and regional integration

- 5 main sections
- > Concept of geographical names and standardization
- Concept of cultural heritage
- > Role of geographical names as cultural heritage
- > Evaluation criteria (historical, common usage, socio-cultural impact)
- > Integration into standardization processes

Key Evaluation Criteria

- Historical significance: verifiability and continuity
- Common usage: resilience and historical evidence
- Socio-cultural impact:
- > local identity
- > cultural uniqueness
- diverse place images (placeness)
- > community belongingness
