



Activities to be conducted on the occasion of the World Statistics Day

- 1. **A poster contest**. The contest for the best posters will be organized to raise public awareness of work of the NSO and to promote its activities.
- A national workshop on "Statistics-2010". The National Workshop aimed to make data the NSO produces more available, improve the national statistical activities by using statistical effective ways and methods, and enhance professional capability of staff in the national statistical system.
- 3. A statistical exhibition. The National Statistics Day, observed by the NSO every year, will be celebrated jointly with the World Statistics Day in 2010. To this end, the following main activities will be carried out:
- Banners for the Statistics Day and advocacy posters prepared by aimag and district statistical divisions, the Municipal Statistics Department, and the NSO will be displayed at the exhibition;
- Statistical publications published by the NSO will be available at the exhibition:
- Users attending the exhibition will be able to receive statistical services and data;
- 2010 Best Statistical Officers will be selected among baghs, khoroos, and soums in charge of statistical activities in their respective areas (administrate lowest units);
- Leaflets containing economic and social indicators of the country will be produced and disseminated;
- Advocacy posters and banners will be placed in concourses;
- Promotional materials and items (pens, bookmarks, table and small calendars etc.) will prepared; and
- Promotional materials for the Population and Housing Census will be prepared and distributed.

4. The World Statistics Day and the Population and Housing Census will be advertised by the mass media.

- Messages from UN Resident Coordinator in Mongolia, leaders of the state of Mongolia, and Chairman of the NSO will be broadcasted;
- Advocacy programmes on the statistics will be broadcasted; and
- Information, congratulatory messages, interviews, and advocacy on the observance of the World Statistics Day will be posted in daily newspapers and popular websites.

5. Sporting events

- Sports competitions (basketball, volleyball, and tennis) will be organized among staff members of the NSO for the World Statistics Day.





6. Entertainment programmes

- A television programme of answers and questions will be organized among students majoring in statistics at Mongolian universities.

7. Webpage

- A webpage advocating the World Statistics Day will be posted on the NSO website.

8. Foreign events

- Representatives from the NSO will attend international events designated to mark the World Statistics Day.
