

World Statistics Day at Poznań University of Economics, Poland

The Regional Council of Polish Statistical Association in Poznań in association with the Department of Statistics in the Faculty of Informatics and Electronic Economy of the Poznao University of Economics organize an open lecture given by Dr. Mauro Scanu entitled *Data integration: an overview on methodologies and applications*. The lecture is intended as a way of celebrating World Statistics Day. The lecture will be held on 20 October in the main University building. Invitation has been extended to researchers and students of the Poznan University of Economics as well as to specialists employed in public statistical services and members of the Polish Statistical Association.

Dr. Mauro Scanu from the Italian National Institute of Statistics is a world-renowned expert in statistical data integration methodology, head coordinator of the European EssNet project on Data Integration, author and co-author of numerous books and articles published in reputable journals. The problem of data integration to be presented during the lecture belongs to one of the most important areas of modern statistical research methodology, providing a new perspective on research that could not be conducted on the basis of single samples. One important effect of combining existing data sources is provision of better information services to meet the needs of modern society and knowledge-based economy.
