Anguilla	<a href="#">Example of disaster precaution: During Hurricane Irma the location of the servers were secure due to how and where they were built as part of risk assessment</a>
Barbados	<a href="#">Formalised NSS statistics network - establishing a statistics network including governmental agencies which produce relevant public data.</a> The role of SDGs as a driving force in Barbados for development of the NSS

Jamaica	Transforming statistical production processes – the Jamaican experience <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Review of core statistical business processes and related quality assurance systems;</li> <li>Development of STATIN's value chain based on the Generic Statistical Business Process Model;</li> </ul> Shift from a functional view of the statistical production to one focused on the processes
Jamaica	STATIN use of eDaCs - an in-house developed electronic data collection system using tablets to inform chapter 8.3.5
Jamaica	Electronic Access to Administrative Data: Reduced dependency on surveys – quarterly GDP, annual national accounts, tourism satellite accounts, employment and earnings
Jamaica	Development of STATIN's quality assurance framework
Jamaica	Disaster precaution: weekly backups of data (internal servers) on tape which are in turn taken off-site. Use of the World Bank's cloud storage for surveys
St Kitts and Nevis	Statistical Advisory Body: In the case of SKN it is comprised of individuals inside and outside of government approved by Cabinet. They make decisions on surveys and data collection activities
Saint Lucia	<a href="#">Accessing Geospatial data - Using a mobile application to collect GPS coordinates for every building on the island based on LiDAR, Light Detection and Ranging</a>
St Vincent and the Grenadines	Disaster precaution: <a href="#">World Bank Caribbean Digital Transformation</a> Program seeks to improve: capacity, storage, resilience, etc.
Suriname	<a href="#">Statistical Governing Body: There is an Governing Board comprising different stakeholders which meets once a month</a>
Suriname	Disaster precaution: e-Store data off premise (Data-Sur) plus another location for security
